Carbon Monoxide Detectors To Be Required in Commercial Buildings

On Friday, May 15, 2015, the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council approved regulations requiring Carbon Monoxide (CO) detectors/alarms in all new and existing commercial buildings and restaurants. The regulation requires all newly constructed commercial buildings or

restaurants to have "hard wired" CO detectors installed pursuant to the requirements of the regulation. Pre-existing commercial buildings and restaurants (constructed prior to June 23, 2015) are exempted from the 'hard-wired' requirement and are permitted to use a carbon monoxide alarm powered solely by 10-year battery power if listed in accordance with UL 2034. The rule also sets forth requirements of monitoring the CO system as well as the proper placement of CO detecting units. Real estate licensees need to be aware of the new requirement and should seek the assistance of a professional for the placement of CO detectors in existing commercial buildings or restaurants.

A copy of the rule can be found here. The new rule took effect on June 27, 2015.


